Subject: - Scheme of Pre-Matric Scholarship for Students belonging to the Minority Communities from 1th to 10th Class. Online application will be accepted under the Scheme for the year 2019-20.

As per instructions of Govt. of India, Ministry of Minority Affairs, New Delhi, the students of Classes 1st to 10th should be online applied for the pre matric Scholarship to Minority Communities in the dedicated scholarship portal under URL: www.scholarships.gov.in. No offline applications will be accepted. It may be ensured that the student will take printout of duly filled up online application through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and will submit the same alongwith all relevant documents to their respective Institutions.

The major conditions of eligibility for filling up online application can be seen at www.minorityaffairs.gov.in and FAQs with regards to Time-Line /various activities relating to submission of application form can be seen on the NSP homepage of the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in. Institutes are directed to verify the applications of the students on NSP portal using their institute User ID and Password before 31st October, 2019

It is, therefore, requested that the eligible students who have applied for scholarship belonging to the Minority Community i.e. (Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Jain, Budhist & Parsi) should fulfill the following conditions:-

Conditions for the Scholarship:-

1. To be eligible, students should have not less than 50% Marks or equivalent grade in the previous final Examination.
2. The annual income, from all sources, of the students's Parents/Guardians should not exceed Rs. 1 Lac. Inter selection weightage is to be given to poverty rather than marks.
3. Income certificate from the employer for employed parents/guardian or Certificate to be issued by the Competent Authority declared by the State Government/ UT Administration.
4. A Scholarship holder of this scheme will not avail any other Scholarship/Stipend for pursuing the same course.
5. Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.
6. Photostat copies of Residence proof, Category Certificates and copy of UID (Adhaar No.), pass book of Bank A/c No. of the Student and also income certificate must be attached with Printout of application form for audit purpose.
